### QUESTION 1

You are using the WMS Cloud at the Stores as well as the DC. Your workflow at that Store requires that you quickly pick orders for the customer when they arrive. Which configuration allows you to achieve this workflow requirement?

### QUESTION 2

### QUESTION 3

- C. You can specify different counts for the different facilities within the Sequence Counter.
- D. You can configure the sequence length for this facility to be different from the other facilities.
- E. You can specify the "Color Code" in the Sequence Counter.
