Correct Answer: B

The symbol is a fuse. Fuses are designed to "blow" (melt) if the current flowing through it exceeds a specified value.

QUESTION 3

What should the temperature of a typical soldering iron be when joining two wires together?

- A. 200 to 300 degrees Fahrenheit
- B. 400 to 500 degrees Fahrenheit
- C. 500 to 600 degrees Fahrenheit
- D. 700 to 800 degrees Fahrenheit

Correct Answer: C

To properly melt solder, you should use a soldering iron heated between 500 and 600 degrees Fahrenheit.

QUESTION 4

A junction diode is used for _____.

- A. rectifying power-line frequencies and lower currents.
- B. rectifying power-line frequencies and higher currents.
- C. rectifying higher frequencies at lower currents.
- D. rectifying higher frequencies at higher currents.

Correct Answer: B

A junction diode has a larger surface area than a point-contact diode, therefore it can be used to handle larger currents at power-line frequencies.
