Correct Answer: ACD

A: MFA requires users to provide two forms of verification, such as a user password plus a notification from the Microsoft Authenticator app or a phone call. MFA greatly reduces the risk that stolen credentials can be used to access your

environment. Microsoft 365 uses the Azure AD Multi-Factor Authentication service for MFA-based sign-ins.

Apart from using passwords, Azure AD Multifactor Authentication adds another layer of protection. You can force users to use SMS, calls, authenticator app, or even go passwordless. The various means to do this are displayed here with the

level of safety for each.



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C: Passwordless authentication is by far the safest. Azure AD MFA can be deployed by creating conditional access(CA) policies. When these conditions are met, users would be required to authenticate using MFA.

D: Block Legacy Authentication

Legacy authentication protocols like POP3, IMAP4, EAS, Outlook Anywhere, EWA, and others pose a security risk. Hence these must be disabled in your tenant. Again you can create a CA policy to achieve this.

Incorrect_ Note E: Privileged Access Workstation (PAW) – This is the highest security configuration designed for extremely sensitive roles that would have a significant or material impact on the organization if their account was compromised. The PAW configuration includes security controls and policies that restrict local administrative access and productivity tools to minimize the attack surface to only what is absolutely required for performing sensitive job tasks. This makes the PAW device difficult for attackers to compromise because it blocks the most common vector for phishing attacks: email and web browsing. To provide productivity to these users, separate accounts and workstations must be provided for productivity applications and web browsing. While inconvenient, this is a necessary control to protect users whose account could inflict damage to most or all resources in the organization.
