Which theorist believed in the zone of proximal development (ZPD)?

Vygotsky believed the potential for cognitive development depended upon the ZPD, which was a level of development

Correct Answer: C



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attained when children engage in social interactions. When the social interaction is guided by an adult or collaborated with peers, the ZPD exceeds what one could achieve individually. Kohlberg is known for his work with moral development; Piaget is known for his theory of cognitive development in children; and Erickson for his eight stages of psychosocial development.

QUESTION 4

A counselor that decides his consultancy fee job-by-job instead of setting a standard rate is using a variable-ratio reinforcement schedule.

Correct Answer: A

A variable ratio schedule is when a reward occurs after an unpredictable amount of responses and typically provides a high rate of response. The counselor\\'s rate is unpredictable from one job to the next. A fixed ratio schedule occurs when a response is reinforced after a set number of responses. Fixed interval schedules reinforce the response only after a certain amount of time has passed. Variable interval schedules reinforce the response after an unpredictable amount of time has gone by.

QUESTION 5

An advantage of having coleaders for a group is:

- A. If one leader is unable to be there for the meeting, it does not have to be canceled.
- B. The leaders can process their own feelings with each other in between sessions.
- C. The leaders can be more observant of group dynamics.
- D. All of the above

Correct Answer: D
