If you hear clicking but nothing happens, the problem could be the battery, solenoid or starter.

Correct Answer: C

A four-wheel vehicle is called a 4×4 if all wheels are driven.

One with six wheels with all six being driven is called a 6×6 , and one with six wheels (like a truck) but only four being driven is designated as a 4×6 .
